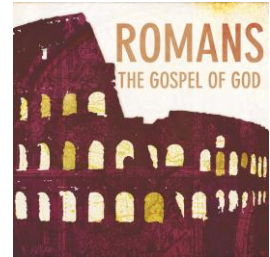

Notes from the Talk

The death of the meta-narrative?

The similarity: just as with Adam ... (v12-14)

sin and death, one man and all men

what about the law?

The difference: gift vs. trespass (v15-17)

v15	Adam	By the one man's trespass many died
	Jesus Christ	By the grace that come by the one man, God's grace and the gift overflowed to the many
v16	Adam	The judgment followed one sin and brought condemnation
	Jesus Christ	The gift followed many trespasses and brought justification
v17	Adam	By the trespass of the one man, death reigned through that one man
	Jesus Christ	Through the one man, those who received God's abundant provision of grace and the gift of righteousness will reign in life

The similarity: just as with Adam ... so also with Jesus ... (v18-19)

v18	<i>Adam</i>	The result of the one trespass was condemnation for all men
	<i>Jesus Christ</i>	The result of the once act of righteousness was justification that brings life to all men

v19	<i>Adam</i>	Through the disobedience of the one man the many were made sinners
	<i>Jesus Christ</i>	Through the obedience of the one man the many will be made righteous
