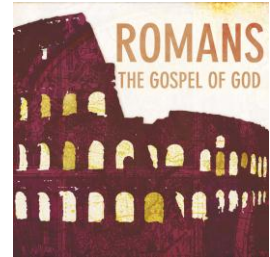

Notes from the Talk

'Really the universe is admirably arranged'

The outcome of the gospel is life lived (1-2)

We have died with Christ to sin, so that we may live with Christ in new life (3-5, 7)

therefore we have died to sin (6-7)

therefore we should count ourselves alive to God (9-11)

The fruit of the gospel is life lived in righteousness not sin (12-14)

Romans 1-5, so far...

1. The gospel is about God's Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, dies and raised from the dead (Romans 1:3-4)
2. The gospel is God's power for the salvation of everyone who believes (Romans 1:16-17)
3. The gospel brings salvation by faith because apart from the gospel all mankind is under God's condemnation and judgment due to sin (Romans 1:18-3:20)
4. Now salvation is available for all through trusting in the death of Jesus to bring justification, redemption and atonement (Romans 3:21-26)
5. Therefore through trusting in Christ we have peace with God and rejoice in his grace and love
6. All this happens because Jesus is like Adam – the head of all those who are 'in him', and therefore the determiner of their status and future (Romans 5:1-10)
