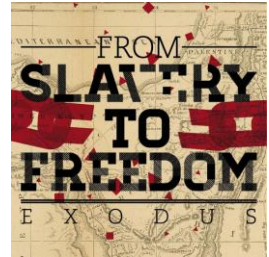

Notes from the Talk

Why read Exodus?

Exodus 1: God protected his people through their cruel oppression

God's promise of a great nation, in a great land, with great blessing to all peoples (Genesis 12:1-3)

A fruitful, numerous people (v. 7)

In a land of oppression (v. 8)

What is God doing?

Exodus 2: Moses emerges remarkably but is forced to flee from the oppressor

Rescued through the Nile, raised in Pharaoh's household (v. 1-10)

Concerned for justice but fleeing to Midian (v. 11-21)

What is God doing? (v. 23-25)

God knows, and is working out his promises for the good of his people

God understands (Hebrews 4:15)

God has acted decisively in history

Moses is a model of faith: he "persevered because he saw him who is invisible."
(Hebrews 11:24)

Be careful not to turn back or turn away like ancient Israel did
