Notes from the Talk

'Should I expect God to speak to me when I read the Bible?'

Five truths about God and his Word

- God is a speaking God (Heb 1:1-4)
- the Bible is God's Word (Heb 1:5-14; 2 Pet 1:12-21; 3:15-16)
- God's Word is enduring (Isa 40:6-8; 1 Cor 10)
- God's Word is effective and powerful (Isa 55:10-11; Heb 4:12-13)
- God's Word is essential and sufficient for life and godliness (Matt 4:1-11; 2 Tim 3:16-17)

Therefore, God's Word is to be our supreme authority

IMPLICATIONS

- i. we should cultivate a devotion to God's Word
- ii. when looking for guidance, expect the expected
